Examinations Reforms

Examination reforms are implemented every year . Annual examinations are conducted by GUG and V.S.K.U , Bellary , but for internal examinations , examination committee at the chairmanship of the convener Dr.B.Nagaraja Reddy with some members, has been constituted for the year 2010-11.This committee referred to the last date of admission and also the total strength admitted . It chalked out the actual strength for conducting tests , mid-term examination and pre-final exams. The plan of the committee was not a simple mechanism but aimed at quality improvement. After conducting each test, the performance was viewed and analyzed through screening . Needful guidance was specially given to the students required . It took care every element for better performance of students . It submitted the test-wise reports to the IQAC for suitable action. It also asked the staff council to prepare the question bank in all subjects and guidelines for preparing study notes. In some cases, the committee also gave valuable advice for extra coaching . This year also , the committee has been more pertinent about the semester exams. The committee collected the question papers for various courses from the staff concerned and conduct the internal tests at right time in each semester.



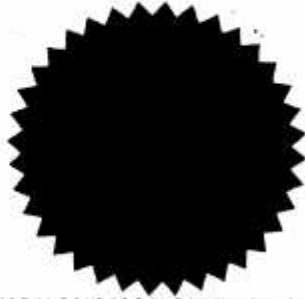

Report—2010-2011




The following activities were held by the science association during the academic year 2010-11.

Placement Cell of Veerashaiva College is striving hard not only to place the students in reputed companies but also giving them training and providing material so as to face interviews confidently in their future career. As part of this, a orientation programme has been conducted in the month of August for all the final year students on the topic 'How to face the Aptitude Tests and Interviews'. In this programme direction is shown to students on how and what subjects to concentrate to build their career over the period of time. The stress is given on Arithmetic, Verbal and non verbal reasoning and English. Along with this, they have been oriented towards Group Discussion, Spoken Skills and how to face interviews.

Apart from training, placement cell acts as bridge between students and companies. It gives all support to the companies which visit campus and also provide data to the companies on request.

In the year 2010-11, the first company visited the campus is J-soft - Jindal's software hand. It has conducted campus interview on 23:07:2010 at the college. 30 candidates appeared for the interview among them 6 was selected.

Distance education has become essential feature and necessity in education field. It is a boon to the persons who are employed and who are deprived of regular studying in higher courses i.e Graduation and Post Graduation. Open Universities have become predominant in higher education in the last two decades. They have taken higher education to the doors of the aspirants. There is no wrong in saying that the present age is the age of Open Universities. They have reached even the remote villages in India. No. of Open Universities are emerging to fulfill the educational desires of the people who have discontinued their education due to employment or other reason. IGNOU is one of such Universities involved in producing human resources of good quality. It has made tremendous contribution to the field of higher education. Now, study centers are opened all over India. Its study centre was opened in Veerashaiva College 19 years back. Right from its establishment it has been running several courses including some highly advanced courses. Veerashaiva College, Bellary was established long back in 1945 by Veerashaiva Vidyavardhaka Sangha which is committed to provide education to each aspirant in this backward region. It has not only been cherishing the values of lord Basaveshwar, the great social reformer of 12th century but also practicing them by providing education to the people irrespective of caste, religion, sex and region.
