HEALTH CENTRE

ACTIVITIES OF THE HEALTH CENTRE DURING 2010-15

INTRODUCTION:

Veerashaiva College is one of the oldest Colleges in the Northern Karnataka region established in 1945. In the interest of students Health Centre was established sometime earlier in the College premises. The main motto and aim of the Health Centre is to provide first aid to the students and faculty of the College, if they suffer with any ailments, the Health Centre is provided with minimum essential drugs and first aid to the students. Health centre has a pharmacist and visiting doctor. After the immediate first aid, the student patients referred to VIMS, Ballari if necessary.

Under the Health Centre very frequently health awareness programmes are conducted in the College campus. Eminent scholars, specialists in medicines and other resource persons are invited to the health centre and the college to address the students.

HEALTH CENTRE ACTIVITIES DURING 2010-11

Ever since, the establishment of health centre by our predecessor various health related programmes are conducting in the College campus. In view of "World diabetes Day" on 14/11/2010, One Dr.Kashi Prasad, Medical Officer, PHC, Ramaiah Colony, Ballari was invited as a Chief Guest. All the Science students of the College were asked to assemble in the College seminar hall. Dr.Kashi Prasad address the gatherings and explained using power-point about the Diabetes. The functions was presided by the Prof. Lingana Gouda the, then Principal of the College.

Again on 01/12/2010 in view of "WORLD AIDS DAY", one Dr.Shafi Saheb Banad, Medical Officer, Blood Bank, VIMS, Ballari was invited as a Chief Guest. During this academic year about 85 students belong to B.A., B.Com. and B.Sc. taken First-Aid treatment in the College Health Centre.

Again on 30/01/2011 in view of World Leprosy Eradication day Dr.P.B.Karuna a resource person from VIMS, Bellary was invited to the Health Centre. He address in a lecture about the eradication of Leprosy. There was an interaction between the students and the resource person. Students raised several doubts and get clarified.

HEALTH CENTRE ACTIVITIES DURING 2011-12

In view of increase in the College strength new equipments and many medicines was ordered for the Health Centre. During this academic year in view of "World Hepatitis Day" a function was arranged near the Health Centre on 16/07/2011. One Sri.Dr.Kadesh, Physician, VIMS, Ballari was invited as a Chief Guest. The function was presided by Prof. Lingana Goud, the, then Principal of the College. Dr.Kadesh in his lecture said that Hepatitis is a viral disease caused due to consumption of contaminated water and foods. He briefed the symptoms, and preventive measures of Hepatitis. At the end of the lecture there was an interaction with the students Dr.B.R.Manjunath and Dr.Rajashekhar, Convener of Health Centre accompanied the Chief Guest on the dias.

In view of “World Malaria Day” on 20/08/2011, a programme was arranged in the seminar hall of the College under the Health Centre in association with NSS unit of the College.

Dr.Kashiprasad, Medical Officer, PHC, Ramaiah Colony, Bellary was invited as a Chief Guest and speaker. He said the female Anopheles mosquito is the vector and plasmodium is the pathogen for the Malaria disease. He gave suggestions for eradication and controlling of malaria disease. Several students attended the function. The programme was anchored by Kum.Monika Nidhi of B.Sc. student. The function was presided by Principal.

Again on 01/12/2011, an account of ‘WORLD AIDS DAY’ an essay, debate, poster making competition was arranged for the students under the health centre. The toppers in the competition were felicitated by the Principal.

HEALTH CENTRE ACTIVITIES DURING 2012-13

In the beginning of academic year on 14/06/2012 in view of “World Blood Donor Day”, a function was arranged in the seminar hall of the College. One Dr.Shafi Banad, Medical Officer, Blood Bank, VIMS, Ballari address the gathering. After his brief speech a blood donation camp was arranged in the College corridor in association with Blood Bank, VIMS, Bellary and N.S.S. unit of the College. As many as 55 students including several girls donated blood.

Again on 24/09/2012 in view of “World Heart Day” a seminar for the students arranged in the Health Centre. Several of the B.Sc.(C.B.Z.) students gave seminar using power-point explaining heart structure, blood circulation and disorders of the heart.

On 07/04/2013, in view of “World Health Day”, a lecture programme was arranged in the College seminar hall. One Dr. Suresh, Dental Surgeon and Physician, VIMS, Bellary was invited as a resource person and Chief Guest. He in his lecture gave health awareness and also about the Dental related problems. He showed various model and photographs using power-point of various gum diseases. The students and faculty raised several doubts and get clarified. The students enjoyed their inter action with Chief Guest. The function was presided by Dr.R.Mare Goud, the then Principal of the College. In This academic year also more than 80 students have taken first aid from the health centre.

HEALTH CENTRE ACTIVITIES DURING 2013-14

College health centre which is situated adjoining to the main building of the College is well equipped and as usual in this academic year also various health awareness programmes and lecture series has arranged under the Health Centre in association with the N.S.S. Unit of the College.

On the suggestions of the Principal, the Convener of the Health Centre has arranged a lecture programme. One Dr. Narasimha Murthy, DAPCU Officer, Bellary was invited as a Resource Person and Chief Guest. His topic was Blood donation and Eye donation. In the course of his lecture he called upon the students and the faculty to donate blood liberally as it saves the life of many people. He said that every adult healthy individual can donate blood twice or even thrice in a year. He said every citizen must donate blood once in a year or at least once in their life time. Further, he also called upon to take the pledge to donate eye after their death. The function was presided by Prof.P.Basavaraj, the then Principal.

On the instigation of Dr.Narasimha Murthy, College faculty, Principal & Students planned to arrange a “Blood Donations Camp”, in the College premises. According on 26/02/2014, Blood Donation camp was arranged in the College Premises in association with Blood Bank, VIMS, Bellary. Several beds was arranged in the College corridor. As many as 75 boys, 28 girls and 04 faculty members donated blood in the blood donation camp held in the College campus. This news was highlighted and published in the most of the national news papers.

In view of more than 100 members donated blood in the blood donation camp, the VIMS Bellary has arranged a special function in the Govt. Medical College, Bellary on 14/06/2014 and felicitated with a certificate and shield to the Principal and Convener of Health Centre and N.S.S. Officers for being arranging such a Big Blood Donation Camp in the College.

Again on 01/07/2014 in view of Doctors Day, under the College health centre some doctors namely Dr.Asharani, Dr.Shafi Saheb.B., Dr.Narasimha Murthy and felicitated by the College for their service. The function was presided by the Principal Prof. P. Basavaraj, it was arranged in the College seminar hall. Several students were attended the function.

In this academic year, State Level Cricket Tournament was arranged in the College Play ground for more than one month, some of the players who injured in the games were given first aid treatment in our health centre.

HEALTH CENTRE ACTIVITIES DURING 2014-15

On 28/08/2014, in view of “World Malaria Day”, one Dr.Kashi Prasad, Medical Officer, P.H.C., Ramaiah Colony, Bellary who was the student of Prof.G.Mallanagoud, who is the convener of health centre was asked to visit our health centre and address the students on the topic Malaria. Accordingly, he came to our College and delivered an excellent lecture. In his speech he said the disease is caused by a protozoan endo-parasite namely plasmodium and this disease is spread by vector namely Female Anopheles mosquito. He gave suggestions to free from mosquito bite by using mosquito repellants, and other products available in the market. He briefly explained the symptoms and control measures. He was felicitated after the function. The programme was presided by Prof. Vedavyasa Sagar in view of Principals’ busy schedule.

Again in this academic year also another “Blood Donation Camp”, was arranged on 11/10/2014 in association with Blood bank VIMS, Bellary. Dr.Shafi Saheb Banad who was the old student of our College and is also in-charge of Blood bank, VIMS, Bellary was present throughout the day in the College campus till the completion of Blood donation camp. About 75 students including girls and college staff donated blood. The individuals who donated blood were given with fruits and biscuits and were also felicitated with a certificate.

On 01/12/2014 in view of “World AIDS Day”, the students were asked to assemble in front of the College main building and were taken a rally with play cards on the main streets of Bellary city. About 86 students were taken treatment under the health centre in this academic year and about 12 students referred to VIMS, Ballari for further treatment.
